RUMFIRE rallied between rivals on turn and through stretch, closed determinedly and was just up. DOWN WITH THE KING, in the five path while just off pace, took the lead leaving furlong grounds but was nailed on the wire. EL TOCAYO, very wide, finished with good energy. HIS REINS OF FIRE was unhurried while in five path, angled out very wide into stretch and finished well. CAPE MAY FERRY set the pace in the three path, resisted but then then gave way late. TRIUMPHANT JOY, between rivals while well placed, faded through the final furlong. CANIFORM hesitated leaving the gate then raced very wide. ALABANDUS saved ground, steadied off heels entering stretch, split foes and was no threat. FIRE SPARX saved ground, drifted out entering the

stretch, moved back to rail and was not persevered with through much of the final sixteenth. ANONYM, two wide and just off the pace, tired. ROCKY THE KID took up after the start then drifted out and showed little. SCOBEYVILLE, just off the rail and just off the early pace, stopped.
