OLD FAITHFUL was away in good order to set a pressured pace from the inside, responded when challenged by AWESOME FIVE nearing the quarter, vied with that foe through a prolonged drive and proved best. AWESOME FIVE pressed the pace of the winner while racing four-wide, moved up to engage nearing the quarter, vied but could not match strides through a hard drive. FLORIDA BOYS was forwardly placed early, raced three-wide through the turn, angled out further into the stretch and failed to gain in the drive. C C'S WARRIOR lagged early, raced off the rail through the turn and finished with some late run. BLAME WILL was bumped soon after the start, raced just off the leaders early, moved four-wide through the turn and gradually gave way. DISCREET DAN was bumped soon after the break, settled off the leaders, moved five-wide through the turn and failed to rally. ROGUE PATRIOT was bumped soon after the start, lacked early foot, raced six-wide through the turn and did not reach contention.
