GORSE prompted the pace from the two path, took over and inherited a clear lead as SWEET BABY JONES stopped at the seven sixteenths pole, stayed clear through the far turn and held sway under driving pressure through the lane. FED FEVER bobbled and bumped at the start with HEART OF A WARRIOR, trailed in the two path around the first turn, split horses in the four path and gained position down the backstretch, then sustained her advance into the lane when shifted to the five path and outside of rivals, and rallied to get up for place at the wire. HEART OF A WARRIOR bumped with FED FEVER at the start, settled far off the pace before gaining ground outside of rivals down the backstretch, sustained his advance through the far turn to bid for the lead in upper stretch, but weakened and drifted inwards in the late stages and was outfinsihed for place. GIACOMO'S THIEF settled off the pace in the three path around the first turn but gained to a striking position into the far turn, held that position without truly threatening the leader around that bend, then weakened between horse at the furlong marker. KNOWN QUANTITY saved ground from midpack around the frist turn, but was outmoved between rivals down the backstretch and stayed on mildly in the five path through the lane. HASHTAG WINNING saved ground while far off the pace, but to no avail. PAUL THE WAITER stalked along the rail, but retreated to midpack before shuffling between horses into the far turn and subsequently tired. INDIGESTION stalked in the two to three path, but weakened in to the far turn and stopped. SWEET BABY JONES rushed after a lackluster beginning to set a fast pace along the inside, but was headed at the seven-sixteenths pole and readily stopped.
