VAULT was caught wide around the first turn while well in hand, moved to the front in the three path just after six furlongs while still under wraps and was under mild urging for a new track record. TURKMENISTAN wasn't far back early, raced the three path between rivals around the final turn and gained the place in an even finish. I'LL TAKE THE CAKE moved to a short lead early on the backstretch, continued in front in the two path for just over six furlongs then drifted through the lane while weakening. SWEET MAGGIE MAE lagged inside to the stretch, angled out and passed tired ones. KICK IT DEEP was caught wide around both turns then tired in the lane. KELTOI made the early pace along the rail, remained prominent to the end of the backstretch then stopped. DROP DEAD RED was outrun after a slow break.
