JIBBER JABBER steadied in tight between horses approaching the quarter pole, angled out three wide nearing the stretch once back in stride, ran clear into midstretch and was kept to task. CIRCUIT JUDGE moved to a short lead from the outside just before going a quarter, raced two wide around the turn then couldn't stay with the winner in the drive. CIRCLE UNBROKEN had position three wide outside the winner for a half then weakened in the lane. GIANT DREAMS broke slowly, moved up outside early, raced four wide around the turn and weakened. HIGH ROLLER saved ground to little avail. TIPSY MOOSE was outrun. GRATEFUL CAUSE made the early pace after an alert break, angled to the rail on the turn, stopped in the lane and was eased up late. CUMBERLAND GAP was outrun after a slow break.
