**Footnotes**

PAL CAL was unhurried inside, came outside early on the backstretch while moving, vied the three path around the final turn, ran clear in early stretch then held. BEALESTREET DANCER began a run along the rail after a half, angled out through the lane and closed a gap in deep stretch. RHYTHM PARK showed speed too wide, moved to a short lead early on the backstretch and tired. NOONAN ON THURSDAY raced three wide between horses around the final turn and lacked a closing. SWITCHBLADE wasn't far back outside early, raced four wide around the final turn and tired. PROMOTE lagged to the stretch then found best stride too late. GOURMET DELIGHT was no factor. BROWNS GAP was hustled inside to make the front entering the first turn and was finished before three quarters. HOWYAFORMONEY stopped. NICARADALIC ROCKS was outrun.
