WRONG COLOR prompted the pace setter while staying in the three path, forged a lead into the far turn and took over approaching the quarter pole, then drew off through the stretch. JULUCA set a moderate pace along the fence while being pressured throughout, got headed by her pressing counterpart into the far turn and proved no match for that rival around the bend, then stayed on her left lead through the lane, but stayed clear of show and was second best. JESSE THE GREAT bumped with MOTHER'S DAY at the start, raced in midpack in the two path before inching forward and chasing the pace setters around the far turn, but failed to make any headway on those rivals through then lane and held show. MINI SCOOP trailed the field to the half mile pole, then angled outside of rivals into the far turn and gained in the three path, then stayed on mildly through the lane without threatening the leaders. LADY A. G. raced far off the pace throughout, saved ground around both turns, but to no avail. MOTHER'S DAY lunged inwards and bumped with JESSE THE GREAT at the start, recovered into the first turn to a stalking position while caught four wide, but was outpaced and weakened into the far turn. UNEMOTIONAL stalked along the inside through the first turn, but faded passing the half mile pole and subsequently stopped.
