MINI SCOOP trailed two wide through the first turn, began a five wide rally while outside of horses into the far turn, angled down to the four path and bid for the lead into the lane, took over in upper stretch, and drew off under driving pressure. JULUCA pressed the pace while three wide, bid for the lead into the backstretch, angled to the rail around the far turn as her inner foes weakened, but was headed by multiple rivals passing the quarter pole, then fought back along the rail through the lane for place. LADY A. G. rated far off the pace and saved ground around the first turn, split foes in the three path around the far turn, then kept on late for show while proving no match for the leader. CUTEFACECHUBYWAIST was antsy to load, raced in midpack, spit foes in the four path into the far turn and made a swift gain to bid for the lead, angled to the two path and forged a slight advantage passing the five sixteenth pole, but was outkicked between horses into the lane and got outfinished for minor rewards. GOLIGHTLY prompted the pace from between horses while two wide into the backstretch, but was driven as other foes made bids into the far turn, failed to keep pace with them around the turn, and subsequently faded. MOTHER'S DAY stalked four wide outside of the trio of duelers into the backstretch, but was outmoved between horses and weakened into the far turn, then was eased while drifting to the five path into the lane. UNEMOTIONAL set a pressured pace along the inside into the backstretch, dueled inside of multiple rivals to the seven sixteenths pole, but weakened badly without coming under pressure into the far turn, stopped, and was eased through the lane.
