BATTLE TAP ran out while showing the way into the first turn, stayed out from the rail under rating, began to widen around the final turn, ran out into the stretch and was kept to whip. GILGIMESH chased along the rail, weakened after six furlongs and held the place. THE ACCUSER bobbled slightly leaving the gate, moved to chase two wide then weakened. RIDE THIS TRAIN was finished after five furlongs then was eased up through the lane. BEALESTREET DANCER came well out from the rail early on the backstretch, failed to respond to whip midway on the backstretch and was eased up.
