MOTHER'S DAY was bumped lightly after the break, moved to press two wide outside the early leader, took over before three quarters and was all out to last. TREASURE TIME wasn't far back inside into the far turn, came out into the two path, vied outside the winner in early stretch, bore out under left hand whip and couldn't get by. FAIRFIELD was bumped into the winner leaving the gate, moved to a clear lead along the rail before a quarter and continued with good courage once displaced. PRIDE IN THE BIZ ducked out into FAIRFIELD leaving the gate, raced the two path to the stretch, angled out and came up empty. BOOM POW POW was slow early, raced the four path around the final turn then was eased up late. GOLIGHTLY wasn't far back in the three path into the far turn, stopped and was eased up.
