VEYA settled in the two path, raced two wide between horses around the final turn, rallied to the front from outside the early leader in midstretch, edged clear in deep stretch then held. BEALESTREET DANCER came out from the inside early on the backstretch while unhurried, rallied three wide around the final turn then closed a gap from the outside through the final yards. THE ACCUSER showed speed two wide, took over entering the backstretch, opened a clear lead nearing the far turn then continued with good courage once displaced in midstretch. NOONAN ON THURSDAY stayed inside and gained mildly. PROMOTE hopped leaving the gate then was no factor. HELLO'NDUBAI made the early pace along the rail and was finished after five furlongs. ROB N THE BANK hit the outside door leaving the gate then was outrun. TEXAS ZIP was outrun when eased up late. JOSHU THE MONK ran out while not far back entering the first turn, fell back quickly then was eased up through the lane.
