GENERAL PADDY was allowed to settle early, rallied four wide around the far turn and into the stretch, reached the front outside rivals a furlong from home and drove clear. WILD ABOUT DEB contested the pace three wide around the first turn, volleyed outside PUMPKIN STAR up the backstretch and around the far turn, stayed on to midstretch and saved the place. DOUBLE WHAMMY pressed the pace inside to the far turn, shifted out three wide approaching the stretch and ran on willingly for a share. HIGH FIVE COTTON was strung out four wide pressing the early pace, stayed in the fight three wide around the far turn and into upper stretch, and was outkicked between rivals. PUMPKIN STAR argued the pace inside under constant pressure from the start to midstretch, and gave way late. MY PIRATE raced three wide around the first turn, moved in a path after that and lacked a rally. ESPRESSO CALIENTE was two wide early, and began to fade inside around the far turn.
