PUMPKIN STAR was rated close up in the two path, moved outside the early leader entering the stretch and was narrowly best after a long drive. VOUCH was rated on a clear lead along the rail, was put to urging into the far turn and gave way grudgingly. HEART OF A WARRIOR edged closer outside on the backstretch, raced the three path around the final turn and weakened. LIBERTY LANE ducked into HERE COMES GARY leaving the gate, improved position three wide on the final turn then flattened out. HONOR AND COURAGE was urged along between horses on the backstretch then tired. KNOWN QUANTITY was bumped shortly after the break, lagged to the stretch and was eased up late. GIACOMO'S THIEF wasn't far back along the rail to the far turn, stopped and was eased up late. HERE COMES GARY was bumped and shuffled back leaving the gate, raced wide around the turns and stopped.
