Footnotes

MAIN COOL CAT was rated outside in good position, moved three wide to the front just after three-quarters, was clear soon after, widened into the lane and held under urging. JONATHANTOQUICK was slow early, rallied the two path around the final turn and finished with good energy between horses. OUT OF LINE wasn't far back inside, was urged strongly to vie inside the winner just before six furlongs then flattened out. JOINT STRIKE advanced the three path around the final turn then weakened in the lane. MANAHAWKIN lagged inside into the stretch then angled out with a belated run. WRANGLE was reluctant to load, moved to a clear lead midway on the first turn, remained in control along the inside for about three-quarters then stopped. GLACIER EXPRESS was reluctant to load, raced three wide and stopped.
