PAPA ZULU was unhurried inside, rallied the final turn, dueled through the lane and drew out late. INDIAN GULCH wasn't far back, raced three wide around the final turn, dueled outside the winner to late stretch then faltered. ANIMAL TRICK was sent clear before going a furlong, angled to the inside entering the first turn, dueled into the final furlong then faded from between the top two. PAT'S SHOES was slow early, came out four wide for room midway on the final turn while moving but failed to sustain his run through the lane. MASTER YANK came out three wide on the final turn and lacked the needed rally. BELLOWS was caught wide around the first turn then tired. NIGHT SPREE was forced wide on the final turn and into the stretch then stopped. HERE COMES GARY dueled two wide, moved out entering the stretch then stopped.
