Footnotes

PAL CAL pressed the pace two wide, assumed command through the far turn and drew off stoutly through the lane to be well clear under strong handling. HOLIDAY TOUCH settled off the early pace, raced two wide between horses into the far turn, shifted three wide into the lane, then moved up in the four to five path at the eighth pole to achieve place, but was no match for the winner. PAT'S SHOES set all the pace along the inside of rivals while a bit off the rail, but was headed by the eventual winner at the five sixteenths pole, and weakened through the drive. CATTLE DRIVE stalked the pace from the inside, saved ground around the turns, but had no rally. SARGENT SUDS stalked the pace three wide while being caught in the four path, was put to an all out drive passing the five-sixteenths pole to keep pace with the leaders, but failed to respond and weakened. JUMP STREET HERO dropped back early and failed to have a response.
