MASONS TURN prompted the pace from the four to three path around the first turn before inching forward at the five furlong marker to duel for the lead while outside of rivals down the backstretch, took over around the far turn and drew off into the lane, then held sway to the wire. HASHTAG WINNING broke in midpack and saved ground into the first turn, but pulled exiting the first bend, was a bit hard to handle into the backstretch and guided to the four path to stalk outside of the leaders, held that position around the far turn before staying on in upper stretch, but was second best and failed to truly threaten the leader. PAT'S SHOES stalked in the two path while inside of rivals, was driven to keep pace into the far turn, held position into the lane, but was bested by HASTAG WINNING for place at the furlong pole. JUMP STREET HERO trailed along the inside into the first turn, shifted to the three path into the backstretch and passed a herded rival, tipped to the four path while still far off the pace into the far turn, came into the lane in the five path, and stayed on mildly. GET A VALENTINE vied for the lead from the two path before dueling between rivals down the backstretch, bested his inner rival and sustained the duel into the far turn, but was outpaced by his outer foe at the five-sixteenths pole, then subsequently weakened along the inside through the lane. DAN SING NIGHTLY tracked from midpack in the two path around the first turn, but was floated to the five path into the backstretch by a hard to handle inner foe, then was never involved thereafter. EGYPTIAN PIONEER led along the rail through the first turn, then was challenged by multiple rivals at the five furlong marker and duelled for the lead down the backstretch, but was outpaced by those foes at the seven-sixteenths pole and subsequently stopped.
