**Footnotes**

CATTLE DRIVE stalked the pace inside of multiple rivals, tipped off the fence around the far turn to bid for the lead in the three path and outside of CASH EXCHANGE at the quarter pole, dueled in upper stretch as that foe dug in, drifted outwards approaching the eighth pole, but prevailed over his inner rival at the sixteenth pole. CASH EXCHANGE established a clear lead into the first turn and stayed in the two path, was loose down the backstretch, met a challenge from CATTLE DRIVE at the quarter pole, dug in turning for home and held the lead to the furlong marker as his foe drifted outwards, but then drifted out himself in the late stages and was bested by his rival at the sixteenth pole. TELLING YOU TWICE settled off the pace and trailed down the backstretch, commenced a four to five wide rally into the far turn, swung to the six path passing the quarter pole, the rallied outside of tired foes for show. CHAMPAGNE PAPI settled off the pace in the three to four path, shifted to the five path and commenced a mild rally through the far turn, but got outfinished by TELLING YOU TWICE in upper stretch, then passed tired rivals for a minor share. SNOOP had a slow start, was caught five wide around the first turn in midpack, advanced to a stalking position into the backstretch, but was coaxed to keep pace into the far turn before weakening in upper stretch. PAT'S SHOES stalked three wide between horses, but failed to keep pace passing the five sixteenths pole and faded. PARAUARI (FR) stalked two wide between horses, but faded approaching the five sixteenth pole and stopped through the lane. HOLIDAY TOUCH stalked four wide, but backed out between horses as PATS SHOES and SNOOP tightened quarters on him at the seven sixteenths pole, then faltered to the six path into the far turn, and was eased through the lane.
