Footnotes

VENUS RAMEY prompted the pace three wide, made a strong bid for the lead into the far turn, drew off handily approaching the quarter pole, built a wide lead in upper stretch, then held sway under driving pressure. GUILTYWITHANEXCUSE hopped at the start and trailed the field three wide down the backstretch, cleared her inner foes and angled to the rail into the turn, slipped inside of rivals at the five sixteenths pole and gained ground around the bend before tipping to the two to three path into the lane, then stayed on willingly, but was second best. L. A. HOUSE was caught four to five wide around the turn in midpack, then stayed on mildly in the late stages to catch tiring rivals for show without threatening the leaders. LITTLE UNITED rushed to duel for the lead along the inside of multiple rivals, was headed by the eventual winner into the turn and immediately put to a drive to keep pace, but was no match approaching the quarter pole and weakened in upper stretch. ANNA MAY OUR QUEEN hopped at the start and was outrun, then saved ground around the turn, and passed tired horses. AXE CAPITAL stalked along the inside, then from the pocket into the far turn, but was a bit off the rail and allowed GUILTYWITHANEXCUSE to slip inside passing the five sixteenths pole, then was floated to the four path when that rival angled off the rail turning for home, and subsequently weakened before being eased in the final sixteenths. PUPPET hopped at the start, was outrun while three to five wide around the turn, and was never involved. ME GUSTA PAPI dueled two wide and between horses early on, but failed to keep pace with them passing the seven sixteenths pole. faltered around the turn, and stopped through the lane.
