ARCELOR settled, came out into the four path while moving on the turn, was bumped while wide into the stretch, moved clear before five furlongs then drew out under urging. PISTOL ANDIE came in after the break, bumped with AGGREGATOR, was unhurried inside, split rivals into the final sixteenth and was up for the place. SWEETLY MAID was unhurried early, stayed inside around the turn and weakened. AGGREGATOR came out, bumped GUILTYWITHANEXCUSE leaving the gate, came out further soon after, bumped with PISTOL ANDIE, angled outside on the backstretch, pressed in the three path into the stretch, was steadied and came out into the winner when pinched back from between rivals in early stretch then tired. PANSY opened a clear lead soon after the break, stayed out from the rail into the turn, bore out into AGGREGATOR entering the stretch then stopped. GUILTYWITHANEXCUSE was bumped leaving the gate, was squeezed back soon after, clipped heels and stumbled then was eased up through the stretch. Objections by Conner against the second and fourth finishers were not allowed.
