Footnotes

PAT'S SHOES broke slowly, steadied while lacking room behind the leaders from near the three-quarter pole until near the four and a half pole, made a run two wide between horses into the stretch to vie, took over nearing midstretch then drove clear after a mile while drifting late. GOTTA GET AWAY dueled two wide, began to get out nearing the lane, came out in early stretch despite right hand whip then couldn't contain the winner while continuing to drift. VIZCAINO was caught four wide around the first turn, advanced outside on the backstretch, vied three wide into the far turn, was carried wide by GOTTA GET AWAY into and through early stretch then faded. An objection by Gonzalez against the second finisher was not allowed. DAN SING NIGHTLY moved to duel along the rail inside the early leader before a quarter then tired after six furlongs. HOLY SNIP fell far back early then found best stride too late. INFORMALITY came outside while not far back on the backstretch, stopped after three quarters and was eased up through the lane.
