PRIZED MERRY dueled inside, moved clear into the stretch and held under steady urging. ESKENFORTIME stayed close to the inside while stalking the dueling leaders, angled out through the lane and gained mildly. SADLER BAY was slow early, made a strong three wide run between horses to vie into the far turn, remained a threat on the outside into midstretch then was eased up. JONATHANTOQUICK was slow early, made a four wide run into the far turn then flattened out. OUT OF LINE dueled two wide outside the winner to the stretch then faded between horses. JONES TAXI tired outside. SUGAR TRAIN stopped. No times were available due to a teletimer malfunction.
