Footnotes

VENUS RAMEY set a pressured pace inside of a rival while staying in the two path, shook loose from the field in the three path turning for home, then held sway under driving pressure. PARANOIA stalked along the inside, attempted a rail bid for the lead in upper stretch, shifted off the fence to the two path inside the final furlong, but did not have enough to catch the leader. ROLL ON BIG MAMA was forwardly placed two wide and between horses, shifted to the four path to be outside of the leaders turning for home, and rallied mildly for minor rewards without threatening the leader. CHARITY STRIPE pressed the pace setter while being kept in the three path, inched closer to make a bid for the lead at the quarter pole, but failed to keep pace with the leader in upper stretch, then weakened and got outfinished for minor rewards. MILE END settled three wide in midpack, came under coaxing into the turn, angled inwards to save ground approaching the quarter pole, but lacked a rally through the lane. HUSH BUFFY saved ground around the turn while trailing, then passed tired outer foes in upper stretch without threatening. LITTLE CHERIE was outrun two wide, drifted to the seven path at the quarter pole, and never got involved. SHARPIN prompted the pace four to three wide, but weakened approaching the five sixteenths pole, then stopped through the lane.
