Supplemental nominations of \$3,000 will be accepted at time of entry, which shall include all fees. The purse to be distributed: \$2,000 to horses finishing 6th through last place; with the balance of the purse to be divided, 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three Year Olds, 122 lbs.; Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 twice in 2019, allowed 2 lbs.; \$60,000 once in 2019, 4 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Nominations closed Wednesday, November 13, 2019 with 25 nominations.

**Footnotes**

FIRENZE FIRE stalked close to the pace while three wide and outside of the dueling leaders, quickened and bid for the lead at the five sixteenths pole, drew off sharply into the lane, then was ridden out under a vigorous hand ride to the wire. MIDNIGHTCHARLY had a slow start and trailed the field down the backstretch, saved ground around the turn before swinging to the six path into the lane, and rallied strongly outside of rivals for place while not threatening the leader. JUMPMASTER was far off the pace down the backstretch, shifted off the rail into the turn, took the bend in the four to five path, then stayed on between horses as MIDNIGHTCHARLY rallied along side into the lane, but was outfinished by that foe while passing inner foes for show. MIDTOWNCHARLYBROWN dueled two wide outside of DUPREE, failed to keep pace with that rival into the turn, kept on for minor rewards in upper stretch, but was outfinished in the final furlong. VORTICITY chased along the inside, failed to keep pace with the leaders passing the five sixteenths pole, tipped off the rail into the lane, split foes two wide at the furlong pole, but lacked a late kick for minor rewards. LEWISFIELD was forwardly placed in the two path between horses, but was forced to steady passing the three furlong pole as MIDTOWNCHARLYBROWN weakened in front of him, shifted to the five path at the quarter pole, but weakened. DUPREE dueled along the inside, put away his dueling counterpart into the turn, but was headed by the eventual winner at the quarter pole, proved no match for that foe, and weakened. AMERICAN RULE bolted to the nine path when asked to angle out from behind horses early on, took the turn in the six path, weakened around the bend, and was never involved.
