Footnotes

CHARITY STRIPE duelled two wide outside of MS TEEK, forged a lead away from that rival turning for home, drew away approaching the furlong pole, then held sway safely to the wire. HEADED FOR HEAVEN settled far off the pace in the two path, trailed into the turn, rallied between horses at the quarter pole, shifted three wide in upper stretch, then kept on to achieve place in the final furlong, but was second best. HER DIVINENESS was off slow, but recovered to stalk the duelers three wide from between horses, was scrubbed on and chased the leaders through the turn, but failed to keep pace with them in upper stretch, and weakened while hanging on her left lead through the lane. MS TEEK duelled inside of CHARITY STRIPE, but gave way to that rival in upper stretch, and tired. SPECIAL RISK angled off the rail to trail outside of rivals into the turn, took the bend in the five to six path, then passed tired in upper stretch without threatening. NAUT A GIVER stalked four wide, but was driven to keep pace into the far turn, failed to do so, and weakened. HIJINKS stalked along the inside, but weakened passing the five-sixteenths pole and stopped through the lane.
