VENOMOUS STATE was never far back outside, raced three wide around the turn, closed outside through the lane and wore down JEEZUM JIM late. JEEZUM JIM took command at once, stayed out from the rail while in charge into late stretch, bore out under left hand whip and gave way. BUILT THAT WAY broke slowly, was unhurried early, raced three wide around the turn then closed outside through the lane. BANG THE DRUM lagged outside into the final furlong then made a late run. DUPREE stayed inside, moved closed into the stretch but lacked a further response. FED FEVER stayed close between horses to the turn then faded. WRONG BEN pressed inside the winner for about a half then tired in the lane. THE BEST CANDY wasn't far back in the four path to the stretch then tired.
