Footnotes

HE'S ZIPPIN ON BY pressed the leader from off of his flank, bid for the lead in hand at the seven sixteenths pole simultaneous with multiple outer foes, outpaced them into the turn and took over passing the quarter pole, drew off in upper stretch and held sway under driving pressure. HOLLYWOOD HANDSOME stalked along the inside into the backstretch before shifting off the rail passing the five furlong pole, made a three wide bid for the lead while between horses at the seven sixteenths pole, but failed to keep pace with those foes at the three furlong pole, was put to a drive around the bend and kept on between horses in upper stretch to prove second best. SNOOP stayed in the three to four path around the first turn before, made a four wide bid for the lead outside of rivals at the seven sixteenths pole, sustained his bid around the turn, but failed to match strides with the eventual winner at the quarter pole, flattened out in upper stretch, and weakened. PENDRELL MOON saved ground around the first turn, but was put to a drive to gain ground into the far turn, shifted to the five path in upper stretch, and offered a mild response while drifting a bit outwards. FLASHY BARON was slow into stride and trailed the field by a distance down the backstretch, was put to a drive into the far turn and offered some late interest in the six path in deep stretch to pass a tired rival. OVERLEVERAGED set the pace down the backstretch, but was headed by the eventual winner into the far turn, held position to the quarter pole, but weakened and stopped through the lane.
