## Footnotes

DRUMMER DON trailed early on, began a rally in the two to three path around the far turn, swung to the five path to be outside of the leaders in upper stretch, and sustained his rally to sweep past the leaders at the sixteenth pole. STOLEN LOVE was forwardly placed four wide around the first turn, angled inwards to the three path and bid for the lead into the far turn, dueled with his inner counterpart around that bend before forging a lead in upper stretch, dug in as multiple rivals made bids approaching the sixteenth pole, but was surpassed by the eventual winner before fending off HOLLYWOOD HANDSOME for place. HOLLYWOOD HANDSOME was bumped between horses at the start, advanced from midpack in the three to four path around the far turn, produced a bid for the lead approaching the furlong pole, but hung, got outfinished by an outer rival, and failed to catch his inner foe foe place. MONEYBAGS saved ground far off of the pace through the first turn, commenced a mild rally in the three to five path around the far turn, but finished evenly. ALGORIX pulled keenly to a two wide stalking position in the three path through the first turn, but came under a drive to keep pace at the half mile pole, failed to keep pace with his rivals at the five sixteenths pole, but kept on through the lane before getting outfinished for a minor reward. THERE HE GOES established a clear lead in hand early into the backstretch while staying in the two path, dug in when confronted by STOLEN LOVE into the far turn, dueled with that foe through the first turn. NIGHT SPREE failed to get involved while caught in the four to five path around the turns. BRIGHT BLUE bumped an inner foe at the start, was outrun in the three path, and showed little.
