DI wasn't far back outside early, rallied four wide around the turn, took over from the outside just before five furlongs, drew clear leaving the furlong grounds then held under steady urging. CUCKOO FORCONONUTS began a run into the turn, steadied in tight two wide between rivals leaving the quarter pole, angled to the outside entering the final furlong and closed a gap in the final yards. RAG TOP broke slowly, lagged into the stretch then made a belated run between rivals. CHARITY STRIPE bobbled leaving the gate, was sent between rivals to press the early leader, moved two wide to the front early on the turn then weakened in the drive. TAKE ME HOME was rated outside early, steadied in tight three wide between rivals leaving the quarter pole then faded in the lane. SWEET DANCER was fractious in the gate then was outrun. LITTLEBITALILY opened a short lead soon after the break, angled to the rail on the turn then stopped in the lane. CACTUS COPY was fractious in the gate, advanced inside early, faded on the turn then stopped in the lane.
