Footnotes

TAKE ME HOME angled towards the rail in the opening furlong, set the pace, edged clear near mid stretch and then held on under strong handling. HEATHERLY, in the four path early, moved to the rail near stretch and closed for place. DANCIN DEBBIE prompted lapped on winner, drifted out slightly leaving the turn and fought gamely to the wire. QUEEN OF SCHMOOZE, three wide and just off the pace, challenged near the stretch, was fanned out soon after and weakened late. UNTOUCHABLE U, racing in the six path early, remained wide and was no factor. LUNA AZTECA, three wide under rating, never threatened. DRIVEN BY SPEED was very wide and showed nothing. ANISSA was never a serious threat.
