OLD FAITHFUL dueled along the inside of a pair of rivals down the backstretch, took back to shift outside of those foes approaching the quarter pole, rebid for the lead in the four path passing the furlong pole, and prevailed under driving pressure. PAPADOPALOUS trailed in the three path turning for home, inched closer to the leaders and shifted in at the furlong pole as the leader drifted outwards, then made a late bid for the lead inside of rivals, but got outfinished. CINDERELA EL CROME dueled three wide outside of a pair of rivals, forged a lead from those foes approaching the quarter pole and built a clear advantage in upper stretch, but tired and drifted outwards passing the furlong marker and gave way between rivals through the late stages. INTERCEPT broke outwards, stalked the trio of dueling leaders from their outside, came into the lane in the five path, but failed to make any headway. SIR ROCKPORT prompted the pace from between the dueling leaders, inched forward to duel for the lead as well into the turn, but weakened passing the quarter pole, and faded while hanging on his let lead through the lane.
