CINDERELA EL CROME rounded the opening turn in the four path then stalked into the backstretch, challenged leaving the seven sixteenths pole, took the nod approaching the quarter, contested the far turn two deep and dug in determinedly to pull clear of JAXBRADENRISHI through the final sixteenth, the latter of whom rated a slim lead inside, came under pressure leaving the seven sixteenths pole, ceded the nod toward the guarter pole, contested the rail on the far turn and dug in gamely to mid-stretch before giving way; reluctantly. KATMAN QUICK saved ground through the first turn then bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole, raced off the rail on the far turn and finished evenly. HOSWAY rounded the opening turn in the three and four paths, bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole, raced off the rail through the far turn and showed little more. NINETYEIGHTTWO stalked the earlier pace from the two and three paths, picked up the chase nearing the three eighths pole then faded through the far turn. JEWEL HEIST saved ground off the pace then faded through the backstretch.
