UNIVERSAL PAYDAY edged up while saving ground past the five eighths, was under a strong ride chasing the dueling leaders past the three eighths, shifted out into the lane, kept on under left handed rousing and forged past the leaders in deep stretch. GALERIO lodged an early bid between foes to entertain the pace, emerged in a battle outside THE POSER leaving the far turn, gained a slim lead under pressure into the lane, wandered outward past the three sixteenths, was corrected with the right stick but failed to shake clear, fought on between runners inside the sixteenth marker but just wasn't good enough. THE POSER bobbed at the break, recovered and advanced to command inside rivals, got into an extended battle to the inside of GALERIO leaving the far turn, ceded command into the lane, fought on past the sixteenth pole then gave way grudgingly. CROUCHELLI lagged off the pace, was under a ride three wide past the half mile marker but failed to generate the needed kick. PAUL THE WAITER , off the pace while saving ground, continued along the rail into and through the lane but lacked a rally. COUSIN JIMMY , with the pace three wide, pursued to upper stretch then gave way. READY AND RICH lost ground four wide, stayed in touch to the five sixteenths, failed to kick on while under a drive and retreated.
