DIG CHARLIE DIG advanced inside, angled out in advancing in the stretch then wore down the pacesetter in the final stride. OUR PHILLY SPECIAL hustled to the front inside, extended his lead on the turn, remained clear in mid stretch but was nailed at the wire. ACED chased off the pace in the two path then flattened out through the stretch. IRISH MEADOW lagged far behind inside, swung very wide in the stretch with late energy. READY AND RICH lacked speed, moved inside and failed to threaten. GREAT GO GO prompted the leaders four wide down the backstretch and faltered. FIVE MORE MINUTES hustled close up three wide then steadied tiring on the turn. MISSION OBERON lacked speed and was always far behind. WILL'S PIONEER forced the pace outside then gave way on the turn.
