FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD FOALED IN NEW YORK STATE AND APPROVED BY THE NEW YORK STATE-BRED REGISTRY. By subscription of \$125 each which should accompany the nomination; \$925 to pass the entry box and an additional \$950 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$1,875 (in addition to the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Three year olds, 124 lbs. Older, 126 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstake since August 1, 2020 allowed 2 lbs.; of a sweepstake in 2020 or three races other than maidenn, claiming or starter in 2020 allowed 4 lbs.; of two such races in 2020 allowed 6 lbs. COLLEGEVILLE GIRL darted over to the rail coming up to the conclusion of the backstretch, brought up the back of the pack one-paced, began to get taken to the outside as the half was being completed, got sent out wider and wider for clearance until in the neighborhood of path seven with a furlong to go, kicked into her best shortly afterwards, overhauled a pair of opponents to her inside in the final strides to prove best. PRAIRIE FIRE loped along in the two path during the opening phases, commenced the stretch one path farther off the rail, gained ground on the ones to catch in a steadfast manner, saw TIMELY TRADITION shift a bit wider in deep stretch after some left side pressure, mustered up a solid burst of speed along the freshly-created open three path corridor to snatch away second. TIMELY TRADITION took up residence in the three path after the start, departed the backstretch and went on to contest the pace as the outermost of a threesome, was still at it when turned loose in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths marker, emerged a sixteenth down the road as the clear leader, dug in with good determination as fresh challengers advanced towards her, crossed over into path four in deep stretch after left side stick work, saw COLLEGEVILLE GIRL move by a few strides later, and then PRAIRIE FIRE steal away the place. OFFICER HUTCHY rated in the pocket, finished off the last stages of the run around the bend lightly hand urged, angled four wide into the stretch, failed to make headway. ESPRESSO SHOT took up the chase four wide on the turn fanned out into path six from upper to midstretch, rallied mildly. FAIR REGIS kept watch on the front runners two wide in midpack, swung five wide into the lane, had no offering during the ensuing furlong then ventured onward not being asked for her best.

BERTRANDA sparred for command from path two in between foes from the top of the turn until midstretch, gave way. SPIN A YARN went over to the rail with the advantage, felt pressure from a pair of foes from her outside after stepping onto the turn, was roused for the drive, gave in midstretch and faltered. NEWLY MINTED saved ground to no avail. MY ROXY GIRL parked out four wide, was through after going a half.
