TIMELY TRADITION away in good order, asked a bit early to make the advantage, showed the way through the turn along the inside, shook clear when straightened for home and maintained a daylight advantage to the wire under steady handling. LADY C in the second flight, moved closer in the two path late in the turn, split rivals past the furlong marker, finished willingly to earn the place, not a threat to the winner. SHE'S A DIME void of early foot, dropped inside midway on the turn, in some traffic a furlong out, finished willingly when clear late. MISS IMPERIAL in the second flight inside, came up empty the final furlong. JACCAT forwardly placed outside, continued three wide turn, also was found lacking when the real running began. FIRST ALTERNATE off the pace and the inside, four wide through the turn, set down for the drive, lacked a serious late kick. LEXINGTON GRACE (IRE) last to leave, raced back, passed a couple of tiring rivals without posing a serious threat. HAWT MESS prompted the winner off the inside, moved closer to that one with a brief bid late in the turn, remained closest to that rival past the furlong marker then faltered late. FULL OF GRACE settled off the early pace, steered out to be three wide late in the turn, faded in the drive. WAR BALLAD trailed throughout in showing little.
