TIMELY TRADITION tracked the pace down the backstretch, went four wide on the turn, was asked outside the five-sixteenths, rallied outside to take the lead at the three-sixteenths then was put to a right-handed whip, fought outside the runner-up under a continued right-handed whip to the wire and prevailed under strong urging. POP A CHOC showed good early speed, pressed the pace on the outside, vied in the three path on the turn, took the lead outside the quarter-pole then was asked, lost the advantage to the winner at the three-sixteenths, fought on with that foe under a right-handed whip into the final furlong, switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while clear for the place. UNION MAIDEN settled on the outside, was asked while five wide on the turn, turned into the stretch under the whip, pursued the top two under a drive into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick but was clear for the show. SAY MOI was taken under a tight hold while outside early, moved in nearing the five-eighths pole, was reserved under a snug hold, saved ground on the turn, was let out a notch around the three-eighths then glided closer passing the five-sixteenths before being taken under a tight hold again behind a foe, steadied while shuffled back behind the stopping pacesetter approaching the quarter-pole, found room and came inside that foe while along the rail in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. CARRIZO broke in then was corrected by the rider, was well placed down the backstretch, went two then three wide on the turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole then driven into upper stretch and also lacked the needed response. FOREVER CHANGED settled towards the rear, went three wide for most of the turn then moved four wide, was given her cue inside the five-sixteenths then driven five wide into the stretch and came up empty. MARYANORINGER moved up to set the pace under pressure to her outside, began to lug out slightly midway down the backstretch, vied in the two path while continuing to lug out slightly on the turn, gave up the advantage without a fight outside the quarter-pole and stopped. DON'T CALL ME MARY bobbed twice at the start, settled under some urging, dropped to the rear at the nine-sixteenths, fell well behind without encouragement in the three to four path on the turn and was eased in the final furlong but walked off.
