Footnotes

HIS NAME IS SUE tracked the pace early on the inside, then was boxed and blocked mid way on the turn while two wide, then eased out and made a four wide bid leaving the quarter pole, split rivals leaving the turn, gained a short advantage by the furlong marker, then held on to win the bob late, driving. STUDIO B was well placed early and made a three wide bid on the turn to gain a short lead by the quarter pole, then had a long drive and dueled by the sixteenths pole and then lost the head bob to just miss. YES IT'S ROO was allowed to settle early, then was three wide by the quarter pole and advancing, angled in by the furlong marker and rallied. SPEEDY MOONLITE vied for the early lead two wide, then was on the inside by the quarter pole and weakened. SIR ROCKPORT was settled early, made a five wide move on the turn and by the quarter pole, but flattened out, then took up late to avoid the fallen foe. NINTH HOUR vied for the early lead on the inside, then dropped back on the turn, swung out four wide for the drive and weakened. HONORABLE SERVICE prompted the pace four wide and came into the drive four wide and weakened, fell by the sixteenths pole, vanned off. There was a stewards INQUIRY concerning the stretch run but after review the race was left as is.
