RUNNINGWSCISSORS forwardly placed along the rail on the backstretch, tipped into the two path coming up to the half mile pole, kept pace with STEAM ENGINE all throughout the run around the bend, was turned loose spinning into the stretch, clawed his way towards the one to catch, dueled on or very close to even terms with STEAM ENGINE from the eighth pole until the final seventy yards, kicked clear, kept to the task at hand. SOUTH AFRICA pocketed for the opening half, angled four wide into the stretch, rallied for the place. STEAM ENGINE cut over to the rail with the advantage, showed the way, attended by the winner from the outside, was set down turning into the stretch, engaged the top one from midstretch to final seventy yards, weakened into the show slot. SCILLY CAY strung out three to four wide on the turn, fanned out into path five from upper to midlane, venturing onward as the widest of all, lacked the needed headway. WOW BROWN underwent a three wide pursuit, had no stretch response. BRONX BOMBER taken hold after stumbling badly at the start, took the inside route on the turn, swung out three wide into the lane, failed to gain. CALL ME HARRY gathered after breaking slightly to the outside, got guided over to the rail, went on to save ground to no avail.
