VIBRANCY stalked the pace, circled the turn four deep, rallied outside foes to take command nearing the sixteenth pole then drew off. UTTERLY ENCHANTING chased the pace three wide around the turn, gained the lead in upper stretch and finished gamely though no match for the winner. MY QUEEN MICHELLE saved ground around the turn while stalking the pace, remained along the rail through the stretch and had a late rally. OLIVE'S BUMPA, in close quarters leaving the starting gate, raced in the two path on the turn, swung to the six path in upper stretch rallied mildly outside rivals. VICTORY TIME set a pressured pace along the rail, drifted to the two path in upper stretch and weakened. PROUD MANDATE prompted the pace between horses, weakened in the stretch and was eased the final furlong. LAST GREAT dropped back early.
