PUBILIUS SYRUS two to three wide at the tail of the field early on, tucked inside near the three-eighths and came under light coaxing at that station, angled four to five wide into upper stretch, rallied outside a trio to take command nearing the eighth pole, dug in to the finish to prevail. DADDY KNOWS established the front and showed the way in hand three then two wide patiently handled and briefly inside midway on the turn, got let out spinning just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under threat from a trio fending them off until yielding near the sixteenth marker, battled on inside to come again and just preserve the place honors on the wire. DUNPH chased just off the inside until tucked inside at the nine-sixteenths, came under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, swung two to three wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive issuing a challenge loosely between foes through the final furlong, briefly passed the aforementioned foe a sixteenth out, fought on to the finish and was nailed for the place honors in the last jump to the wire. HAMMERIN AAMER chased three to four paths off the inside in closest aim of the leader down the backstretch, tucked three then two wide through the turn placed to coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled three to four wide for home, threatened mildly to the eighth pole, then weakened in the late stages. GRIT AND GLORY brushed the near side stall at the start under coaxing, chased just off the inside under a ride from three furlongs out, went three to four wide into upper stretch and tired. ROAMING UNION bumped at the start by AMERICAN LINCOLN, who recovered inwards from a stumble, chased just off the inside until tucked inside five furlongs from home, got coaxed along at the three-eighths, spun two to three wide at the head of the stretch and tired. AMERICAN LINCOLN stumbled at the start recovering inwards and bumping with ROAMING UNION, chased three to four wide down the backstretch and then two to three wide through the

turn under a ride from midway, went six wide into upper stretch and tired. KING OF AMERICAN four to five paths off the inside down the backstretch in pursuit from mid pack, tucked three wide through the turn and was placed to coaxing three furlongs out, swung four wide at the top of the stretch and tired.
