KAYLASAURUS was settled early, then made a four wide move by the quarter pole, continued that bid and closed well in the stretch, drew clear the final sixteenth to prove best going away. FLATTERING RUBY set a pressured pace early in the three path, then dueled for a bit on the turn, then shook clear leaving the five sixteenths, remained clear by the furlong marker, but was headed nearing the sixteenth pole and could not go with the winner, second best. TARA'S TALENT chased the early pace two wide, swung out four wide for the drive and was up late for the show award. S W BRIAR ROSE pressed the early pace four wide, steadied by the nine sixteenths, then faded losing the show award late. BACI pressed the pace inside then dueled for the lead on the inside and weakened. MS TEEK steadied shortly after the start, then was no threat. AVA O stalked the pace five wide and stopped.
