ACADIAN GIRL rated a short lead inside, was urged into the far turn, widened at the rail and was steadily handled in the lane. DIVINE FASHION saved ground off the pace, started a bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole, raced near the rail on the far turn and had to settle for second best. VOLNAY stalked the earlier pace two deep, gave chase leaving the half mile pole, raced in the three path on the far turn and took the nod for third in the final stride. TEQUILA FOG settled off the rail on the opening turn, gave chase past the seven sixteenths pole, raced at the rail on the far turn and ran evenly down the lane. HIDDEN IDENTITY saved ground close to the pace but was boxed at the rail nearing the half mile pole, picked up the chase past the three eighths pole, rounded the far turn near the rail and flattened the final sixteenth. RED QUEEN raced in the three path the first turn, gave chase from the seven sixteenths pole, rounded the far turn about the three path and weakened in the lane. MI CLEOPATRA AND I closed toward contention three wide through the front stretch, raced in the three and four paths on the opening turn but showed little response through the backstretch.
