### Footnotes

TAPIT'S GIRL was well rated early, saved ground on the turn, shifted out and came three wide to make a bid, then dueled for command by the sixteenth marker and got the nod late to prevail under a drive. BRUNELLA pressed the pace and made a two wide bid on the turn to gain a short lead, then shook clear leaving the turn and dueled for command the final sixteenth and just missed. ROSES FROM HEAVEN chased the pace and was four wide on the turn, came six wide into the lane and had a late rally to get the nod for the show award. HIGHTIME VALENTINE was reserved early, came widest into the lane and had a belated rally, just missed show award. KNICKERSINATWIST stumbled at the start, settled early and advanced three wide on the turn and came five wide into the drive but flattened out. GUSSIE'S NOTION stalked the pace three wide and came four wide into the lane and was empty. SWEET AND MACHA set the pace on the inside and faltered.
