BRUNELLA was in pursuit early on while racing three, took command into the turn and drew off to be well clear under steady pressure. QUEEN'S DREAM chased the early pace, raced four wide near the quarter pole and finished willingly to the wire. AMEN SYLVIA raced off the early pace, was three wide near the quarter pole, angled to the rail and got up for the place position late. LANFRANKOPHILE was coaxed along early while racing between rivals and weakened in the final stages. DETERMINED HOPE was bumped at the start, raced off the early pace, was six to seven deep into the upper stretch and had no late rally. KNICKERSINATWIST broke to the outside, showed good early foot to set the pace from the inside and faded. ROSES FROM HEAVEN was bumped at the start, raced five wide near the three sixteenths pole and tired.
