LIVE FIRE was well placed early and saved ground on the turn, made a inside bid leaving the turn and kicked clear by the furlong marker, then held sway late to prove best under a drive. COURT AND SPARK chased the early pace and was on the inside to two wide leaving the turn, then moved back down to the inside and closed well. ROBBY'S RANSOM tracked the pace and was three to four wide on the turn and was gaining late. BLAME IT ON HONEY dueled for the lead on the inside and was two wide by the quarter pole, faded the final furlong. SUNSHINE MAX was settled early, then was four to five wide on the turn and had no kick. DRAMATIZED was reserved early, saved ground on the turn, angled out in the drive and had a belated rally. MORNING MARCH failed to menace. UNCLE REMI dueled for the lead three wide and stopped.
