Footnotes

GARY DOING BIZ rated close inside, gave chase approaching the five sixteenths pole, eased out leaving the turn and dug in to get up the final yards. GOT YOUR NUMBER accelerated to the front approaching the three eighths pole and set a pressured pace, contested the rail on the turn, dug in leaving the turn but was caught in the final yards. DEEMED ESSENTIAL chased and rounded the turn in the three path, was carried out a path entering the stretch but finished well while dueling for third. CHEESE LOUISE chased through the backstretch, rounded the turn in the five path, was outfinished in the stretch duel for third but finished well. AT THE HALF chased through the backstretch, ran at the rail on the turn and finished evenly. TRAVEL GIRL had a brief early lead then gave chase, raced close off the rail into the turn, drifted a bit into the lane and weakened the final furlong. ADABEL engaged in close early chase then faded into the turn. SHUTUPN'KISSME was unprepared for the start and broke in the air.
