SUGAR SMILE was settled early, advanced two wide on the turn, then dropped to the inside leaving the quarter pole and made a inside move leaving the turn and got thru on the rail leaving the furlong marker and edged clear to prove best under a drive. JACK'S LILLY stalked the early pace and made a three wide bid on the turn and ran on to the wire but was outfinished. SPUNKY ZOEY stumbled slightly at the start, rushed up the inside to vie for command, then shook clear on the turn and came two wide into the lane and faded the final furlong, held show award. DOWSER was settled early and made a four wide move on the turn to loom boldly by the quarter pole but flattened out, missed show award. FREEDOM CHEER was well placed on the inside and then was roused by the quarter pole and angled out leaving the three sixteenths pole but lacked a bid. BE LIKE BETH vied for the lead two wide and weakened.
