LA CIENEGA set a pressured pace in the two path, shook clear by the quarter pole and then kicked away leaving the turn and then widened the margin the furlong grounds to prove best under a drive. HEAVENLY HEART was rated early two wide, then shifted out and made a five wide bid nearing the quarter pole and loomed boldly by the furlong marker, but could not go with the winner late, second best. NO EASY ANSWER was well placed along the inside, angled out leaving the turn for aim on the winner but faded. OUR JESSICA JOAN was allowed to settle early, then saved ground on the turn and passed the tiring rivals on the inside. DOWSER was allowed to settle early and was four wide on the turn and came five wide into the drive and had no rally. ECLIPTICALS SARAH pressed the pace three wide and weakened. KNICKERSINATWIST stalked the pace four wide and then was empty.
