## **Footnotes**

SACHMO raced in the two path around the first turn, settled in the middle of the pack for the run up the backstretch, began a bid from the two path coming around the second turn and kicked clear late. ET'S MAGIC MAN bumped mildly with the horse to her inside at the start, raced in the two path early, settled off the pace for the run up the backstretch, began a bid while saving ground around the second bend and gained ground late from there. SAPONARA bumped lightly with the horse to her outside leaving the gate, saved ground around the first turn, tracked the leader on the inside up the backstretch, swung out to the five path coming around the second turn and improved position in the lane. MEMORY BOUQUET saved ground around the first bend, led the way up the backstretch, dueled from the three path around the far turn and weakened in late stretch. RESTORED ORDER raced in the two path around the first turn, chased the leader on the outside up the backstretch, challenged from the four path coming around the far turn, dueled in upper stretch and gave way late. LACCO AMENO was away from the gate slowly, saved ground at the back of the pack around the first turn and up the backstretch, continued to save ground around the second turn and made no bid. LA PAZ raced in the two path around the first turn, stalked the leader on the outside up the backstretch, came around the turn in the three path and faded in the lane. WILL E SUTTON raced at the back of the pack in the two path through the opening half mile, trailed the field while saving ground around the far turn and was empty in the stretch.
